

**WEATHER REPORT ISSUED BY THE MARINE METEOROLOGICAL CENTER
SPLIT ON 09.10.2005. AT 1300 HOURS**

WARNING:

GUSTS OF NE WIND IN THE VELEBIT CHANNEL, REACHING 30-40 KNOTS.

SYNOPSIS:

A shallow low over the Tyrrhenian Sea is slowly filling up, while a ridge of high pressure is intensifying from eastern Europe toward the Adriatic.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR THE ADRIATIC FOR THE FIRST 12 HOURS:

Along the coast NE and E, in the afternoon NW and W wind in places, reaching 5-15 knots. In the Velebit Channel NE wind 12-24 knots. In the open sea E and NE, in the South Adriatic SE wind, 6-14 knots, gradually turning to NW wind. Sea 2-3. Visibility 10-20 km. Variably cloudy, still with a risk of scattered rain or isolated rainshowers and thunder in the open of the Central and South Adriatic at first.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 12 HOURS:

Along the coast light to moderate NE, in places of the North and Central Adriatic up to fresh. In the open sea light to moderate NW wind. Sea smooth or slight. Settled and mostly clear with some passing clouds at times.
